Where we are now

- **Intellectual Output 1: Innovative Methodology for education and training of adults living rural areas;**
- Intellectual Output 2: Training Manual with 5 modules for digital skills for adults in rural areas;
- Intellectual Output 3: A new and innovative Board Game.

At the beginning of the project, the partners have been involved with some research to confirm the real needs of the people to whom the project was addressed.

Survey analysis and desk research were conducted in partners' countries.

The consortium has produced two detailed reports to interpret the surveys and desk research.

Countries in Europe have very different levels of digitization. This depends on many factors not only relate to age but also with the territory and the different policies that have been pursued by governments.

Desk research provided us with a starting framework to be able to act more effectively with the actions of our project.

At the same time, 148 questionnaires were collected from adult learners and 158 questionnaires were collected from adult educators and stakeholders. **This survey** allowed us to determine the digital skill level of adults living in rural areas in relation to the **5 DigComp skill areas**.

Innovative Methodology for educating and training adults from rural zone to improve their digital and ICT skills

The main outcome of Intellectual Output 1 is an **Innovative Methodology** that uses a mixed learning approach to educate and train adults living in rural areas. People living in these conditions are more likely to develop social and occupational isolation. Increasing their skills could allow a strong chance for them to improve their living conditions. For this reason, we created a document to support teachers, trainers and those who are involved in educating and training adult learners in their effort to spread the importance of learning digital skills.

By starting from the competence areas of the **DigComp**, the European Digital Competence Framework, we have developed a learning program in 5 modules: information and data literacy; communication and collaboration; digital content creation; safety and problem solving.
